



Dear Parents of Vista Ridge,

When bringing your child(ren) to Pajama Night we ask that you discuss the following rules with your child(ren) before they come. These rules have been put in place to ensure the safety of your child(ren) and to make Kids Pajama Night a fun environment for those who attend.

The rules are as follows:

- No roughhousing with fellow children – to include but not limited to:
Kicking, pushing\pulling, wrestling, scratching, and spitting
- No screaming
- Children will listen to and obey the Community Center Staff Members who are hosting that night. If they repeatedly disobey the staff members or do not follow the above rules the following disciplinary policy will be put into place:
 - The child will be asked to stop the bad behavior
 - The child will be placed in time out
 - The child will be sent home
- Children who are continuously disruptive will be suspended from attending any further pajama nights. The length of this suspension is at the sole discretion of the Community Center staff.

Parents, we would like to thank you for your cooperation in making sure that our Kids Pajama Night is a fun event for all. Your support is essential so that we can continue to offer this fun event to the kids and to you.

Rules for signing your child up for Pajama Night:

- Pajama night is limited to 20 kids.
- Sign up is on a first come, first serve basis.
- Sign up for the next pajama night will begin the Saturday after the previous pajama night. This is to allow those who were not in attendance on pajama night the same chance to sign up.
- No sign ups will occur during a pajama night.

Please Note: The Community Center provides dinner for your children at Pajama Night. If your child can not or will not eat what the Community Center Staff has prepared, please send an alternative meal with your child.
